Instructions for Applicants



1. Applicants must be American Indian residing in North Carolina and enrolled in a state or federally recognized tribe.
2. Applicant must be an incoming freshman enrolling in a two year or four year college or university, and/or freshman, sophomores, juniors or seniors who are enrolled and still attending a two-year or four-year college or university.
3. Applicants must be enrolled as full-time students.
4. Only completed applications will be accepted for consideration. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
5. Applicants must apply for all **other sources of funding** for which they are eligible.
6. Applications will be competitive. We expect to award five \$500.00 scholarships for Fall 2019.
7. The screening committee will use a point system to score the applications on academic achievement, grade point average, career plans, American Indian activities, extracurricular activities, community involvement, references and essay.
8. Winners will be announced Saturday, March 9, 2019 during the morning General Assembly at the 44th Annual North Carolina Indian Unity Conference at the North Raleigh Hilton (3415 Wake Forest Road Raleigh, NC 27609).
9. A student who has received the United Tribes Scholarship once will not be eligible to receive it again in any category.

 6. If you choose to do so, write a brief statement of any financial **hardships** you may have.
 7. Copy of letter of admission/acceptance from a college or university. If letter is not available, please make notation and send as soon as possible. **No student will be awarded a scholarship until United Tribes has received "proof of enrollment" from your college.**
